Re: Animal GRAS Notice No. AGRN 52

Dear Dr. Lewis:

The Food and Drug Administration's (FDA or the agency) Center for Veterinary Medicine (CVM or we) received a generally recognized as safe (GRAS) notice (M-000114-A-0000), dated August 26, 2021, submitted on behalf of your client Jiminy's LLC (Jiminy's or the notifier). The subject of the submission is crickets as a source of protein in complete food or treats for adult dogs at a level not to exceed not exceed 16% by weight of the diet. The submission informs us of the notifier's conclusion that the subject of the submission is GRAS through scientific procedures. Additionally, we received amendments dated October 6, 2021 and November 1, 2021, providing a reference cited in the notice, an authorization for representation letter and an amended notice. The notice, as amended, was filed on November 15, 2021 and designated as animal GRAS notice number (AGRN) 52. During the evaluation, we received an amendment, April 20, 2022, in response to a request for more information to address utility, target animal safety and chemistry, manufacturing and controls questions. In a July 7, 2022 email to you, we informed you of questions in regards to the GRAS conclusion related to the target animal safety, utility, and chemistry, manufacturing, and controls of the notified substance.

CVM is granting your request, on behalf of Jiminy's LLC, dated August 5, 2022 to cease evaluation of AGRN 52.
