Research

My research activities primarily involved community-based participatory work, with a focus on health disparities. My main area of interest is tobacco dependence. I have developed, recruited for and conducted focus groups that explored factors that influence the initiation and use of tobacco, as well as perceptions of cessation interventions, among sexual/gender minority youth, who have dramatically high rates of tobacco use, and can be more difficult to reach. As a clinician-educator, I am looking at ways to improve patient care, including evaluating whether revision of the current automatic protocol for prescribing nicotine replacement therapy, and including other options, will result in changes in prescribing patterns.

Teaching

I have been involved at all levels of education within the UNM School of Medicine and strive to stimulate critical thinking. I was a member of the Phase I curriculum committee for the Cardiovascular/Pulmonary/ Renal (CVPR) block for 17 years, a block highly regarded by learners, and for which I wrote several cases. I enjoyed being a tutor for many years, primarily during the CVPR block. In addition to giving presentations during the block, I have participated in the Medicine residents' noon conferences and Thursday school. I am an alumna of the Medical Education Scholar program (2005-2006), was a member of the Tutorial Case Working Group (2000-2006) and the Tutorial Steering Committee (2002-2007) and became a Master Tutor in 2010.

I am the site director for UNM Internal Medicine Residents and UNM Pulmonary and Critical Care Fellows on the NMVAHCS Pulmonary Consult Service, with up to 3 residents (Internal Medicine, Anesthesiology) and one fellow rotating every 4 weeks. I guide clinical learning, provide didactic sessions relevant to patients seen, and am in the process of developing a curriculum to incorporate core topics and skills. I supervise residents and fellows in bronchoscopy, thoracentesis and chest tube placement and management. For many years, Phase II students participated in a weekly clinic with me, and I have precepted continuity clinics for Phase III learners, as well as Internal Medicine residents. From 2012-2014, as director of the pulmonary component of the NMVAHCS Scan-Echo telemedical education program I developed the curriculum and organized the didactic sessions, giving many myself.

Service - Patient Care

My clinical work is with the New Mexico Veterans Affairs Health Care Services, as a staff pulmonologist, and medical director of both the pulmonary function lab and the home respiratory care team. Until 8 years ago, I was also an attending in the medical intensive care unit. I currently spend 26-30 weeks a year on the inpatient consult service and have 3 half-day clinics per week. I see patients with all types of respiratory disease and have expertise in tobacco dependence and treatment modalities. I am skilled at motivating patients to pursue changes in behavior. I enjoy working in interdisciplinary settings and participate in the weekly multidisciplinary chest conference at the VA (Pulmonary, Thoracic Surgery, Interventional Radiology). We primarily discuss the evaluation and management of patients with lung nodules. In my role as medical director of Home Respiratory Care since 2005, I have worked to expand patients' options for supplemental oxygen and improve the quality of care. I work closely with the Pulmonary nurse manager to address the concerns of individual patients, and implement use of innovative technology, such as portable non-invasive ventilators.

Mentoring of faculty in research or scholarship

The VA did not have any junior faculty in Pulmonary for many years, which limited mentoring opportunities. While on the executive committee of the CCR, I wrote the nominating letter, and successfully advocated, for Dr. Harkins to receive the well-deserved ATS Clinician of the Year Award. I have mentored, and advocated

for ATS committee membership for several faculty, including Dr. Harkins (Clinicians Advisory committee), Dr. Akshay Sood (Environmental Health Policy), and Dr. Shozab Ahmed (Education committee). I have met often with our early career professionals to mentor them and encourage their participation in professional organizations, and provided guidance for national recognition and advancement of their careers outside of New Mexico.

Within ATS, I have mentored several early career investigators.
