Import Safety
Lookup Portal

Used to search, create, update and obtain domestic and foreign facilities DUNS number.

UFI pending

FDA has not approved the UFI. Registrant has to provide valid, accurate DUNS number within 90 days.

Mismatched UFI

Information in section two of the FFR and DUNS do not match. UFI **must** be exact legal name, address etc.

Invalid UFI

DUNS registration is not accurate.

FSVP

Importers are required to have foreign supplier verification program.

Registration Requirements

- The owner, operator, or agent in charge of a domestic or foreign facility engaged in manufacturing/processing, packing, or holding food for consumption by humans or animals in the United States is required to register the facility with the FDA.
 - Food facilities must be registered before such operations begin.
*“Facility” includes any factory, warehouse, or establishment that manufactures, processes, packs, or holds food.
 - Food facilities are required to submit an initial registration to FDA and renew registration during the period beginning on October 1 and ending on December 31 of each even-numbered year.

Qualified Facilities

- Even if you plan to attest as a qualified facility, you MUST still register.
- Your attestation can be completed after your food facility registration.

Registration Exemptions

1. Certain foreign facilities
2. Primary and secondary production farms
3. Retail food establishments
4. Restaurants

Registration Exemptions

5. Nonprofit food facilities
6. Fishing vessels
7. Facilities regulated exclusively by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA)
8. Private residential facilities

Who may register a facility?

- The owner, operator, or agent in charge of a facility that is required to register may authorize an individual to register the facility on its behalf.
- NOTE: There is no fee for initial registration, renewing a registration or to update a registration.

UFI and DUNS Numbers

- FDA recognizes a DUNS number as the only acceptable UFI.
- The UFI will be used by FDA to verify facility information.
- A DUNS number is a unique nine-digit numeric identifier used to identify a facility.
- The DUN number is assigned and managed by Dun & Bradstreet (D&B).
- Import Safety Lookup Portal

- **Note:** Acquiring a DUNS number can take 45 days to acquire.

Extension of UFI Requirement

- FDA extends flexibility of UFI requirement through December 2022.

Common DUNS Mistakes

- Do not use the agent or shipper information.
- Do not use the headquarters location; each physical location needs a DUNS number.
- Name and address variations will cause issues.
- Facilities legal name, address and the fields in the FFR and DUNS must match exactly.
- Failure to update the registration with a valid DUNS number can result in cancellation.

- If a registration is not renewed by 11:59 PM on December 31, 2022, the registration is considered expired and will be removed from your account.

Registration Renewal

- Registration is the initial process of registering
- Renewal occurs every two years (even numbered years) during the Biennial Renewal Period.
- Log into the Food Facility Registration (FFR) system at: [FDA industry systems - Accounts management](#).
- Use your PIN to access the renewal portal.

- FDA will consider a registration expired if not renewed.
- Foreign facilities that fail to register/renew may have imports into the U.S. held at the port.

Failure to register/renew is a prohibited act.
