Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to provide you with an important update regarding the recent Mo 99 shortage and the timeline for return to market of Curium's Ultra-Technekow™ V4 (technetium Tc 99m generator).

Given the recent and unforeseen challenges with the BR2 reactor, we have been in contact with the operator of the HFR reactor about a possible early restart. HFR has since confirmed the next cycle will begin one day early on November 23. Therefore, Curium's plan to resume production of Ultra-Technekow™ V4 generators will ramp up to normal levels over the following days:


- Sunday, November 27: significant reduction of available Mo 99
- Monday, November 28: slight reduction of available Mo 99
- Tuesday, November 29: extra production day to help increase market supply of Mo 99
- Wednesday, November 30: normal levels of available Mo 99

Going forward, we expect the supply of Mo 99 and production of generators to return to normal.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as the industry navigated this temporary and short-term disruption in supply. We understand the impact that any disruption has on productivity and patient care and look forward to providing you with the reliable service you expect from Curium.
