Notice of Intent to Limiting sources to: **Optronic Laboratories**

Pursuant to the authority of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 8.405-6 (a)(i)(1)(B), (only one source is capable of providing the supplies required at the level of quality required because the supplies are highly specialized), the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) intends to award a delivery order to **Optronic Laboratories**.

FDA has a requirement to obtain Tune- up and Calibration Services for IEC 62471 Spectroradiometer System as a Sole Source acquisition.

The original manufacturer Optronic Laboratories is the only vendor authorized to perform the proprietary tune up and calibration services of the equipment. Optronic Spectroradiometer System is a proprietary system and only the manufacturer has the trained professional personnel who have the knowledge and capability to ensure the proper services are performed. If the services were performed by other than Optronic Laboratories, it could result in damage on the order of the purchase price of the equipment to remedy. Optronic Laboratories is a sole source provider for the preventive maintenance, calibration, and repairs IEC 62471 Spectroradiometer System.

The NAICS Code for this procurement is: 334513 - Instruments and Related Products Manufacturing for Measuring, Displaying, and Controlling Industrial Process Variables.

This notice is not a request for competitive proposals. However, any party that believes it is capable of meeting this requirement as stated herein may submit a written capability statement that clearly supports and demonstrates their ability to perform the requirement. Capability statements must be received by the response date and time of this notice. Submissions will be reviewed to determine if they can meet the requirement. A determination by the Government to compete this proposed contract based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government.

It is anticipated that an award will be issued to Optronic Laboratories within approximately fifteen (15) days after the closing date of this notice unless the Government determines that any other organization has the capacity to meet this requirement.
