
1. Office of Dietary Supplement Programs (DCRKC).

- A. Leads the policy development and strategic management of the dietary supplement program. Implements the dietary supplement provisions of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to ensure the safe marketing and truthful labeling of dietary supplements.
- B. Provides expert advice and communications throughout the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), other federal entities, United States and foreign government officials including Congress, and external stakeholders including industry, international and domestic organizations on dietary supplement programs and policies.
- C. Oversees the implementation of manufacturing and labeling requirements related to dietary supplements.
- D. Advises on chemistry, toxicology, microbiology, and clinical research in dietary supplements.
- E. Evaluates risk assessments, adverse events, and other sources of signals related to the safety of dietary ingredients and supplements and directs appropriate management activities.
- F. Provides expert scientific, technical, and policy review and support for dietary supplement related enforcement actions.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Dietary Supplement Programs were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services on March 5, 2024, and effective on May 13, 2024.
