

## 2024 FDA Scientific Computing and Digital Transformation (SCDT) Symposium Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

### General Symposium FAQs

#### How do I register for the Symposium?

Please visit the [2024 FDA Scientific Computing and Digital Transformation \(SCDT\) Symposium webpage](#) to register for the Symposium. Once registered, attendees will automatically have virtual access to the events on November 4, 5, and 6. The Symposium web page will be continuously updated with important information.

#### Is there a fee to attend the Symposium?

No, the SCDT Symposium is free and open to the public.

#### Are you accepting sponsorship for the event?

No, the FDA is not accepting any sponsorship for the event.

#### How many people from our organization may register for the Symposium?

Due to limited space, we ask that you limit your organization's in-person attendance to three people. Please encourage additional members from your organization to attend virtually.

#### Will a vendor or attendee list be made available?

No, the SCDT Symposium will not be hosting a vendor session this year.

#### Can I obtain a certificate of attendance?

No, the SCDT Symposium does not qualify as a continuing education course.

#### Are you making accommodations for Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024?

Note that on Tuesday we will start the Symposium one (1) hour later at 10:00 AM (EST). You may also want to consider alternative voting methods, such as early voting, etc.
