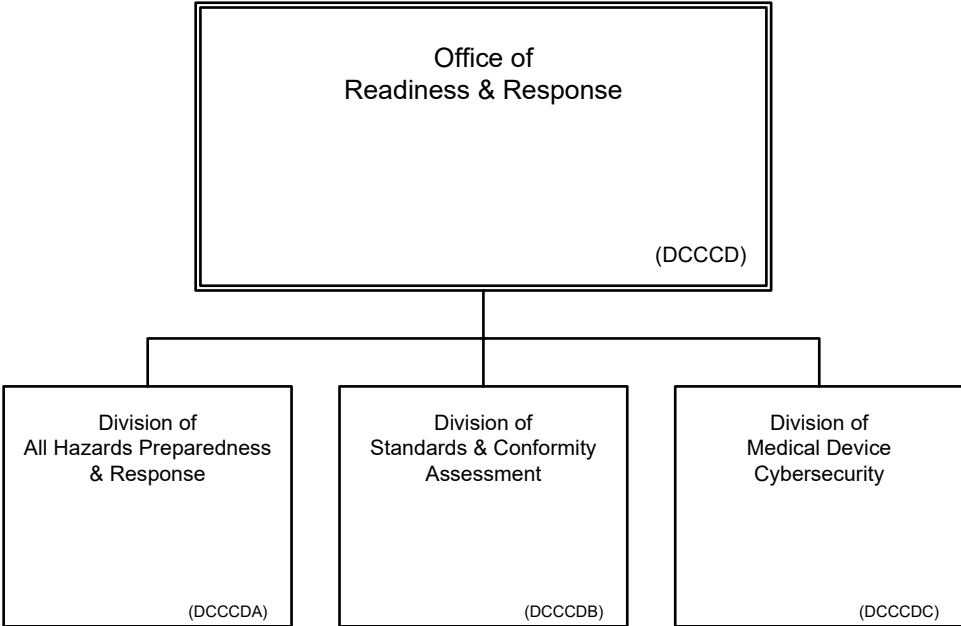
**1. Office of Readiness and Response (DCCCD).**

- A. Provides leadership, oversight, and coordination in matters relating to emergency preparedness and response involving the products or facilities regulated by the Center for Devices and Radiological Health (CDRH).
- B. Provides global leadership and innovation in standards implementation and utilization for medical device development and manufacturing and radiation-emitting product safety.
- C. Provides leadership and strategic direction on the cybersecurity of medical devices.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**

The functional statements for the Office of Readiness and Response were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services on July 27, 2023, and effective on August 8, 2023.
