1. Division of Digital Health Policy (DCCCFA).

- A. Provides oversight and leadership in the development, review, and implementation of legislation, regulations, policies, procedures, and guidances related to software and digital health technologies across the life cycle.
- B. Serves as an expert resource for software and digital health policy matters by providing advice and consultation to the Center for Devices and Radiological Health, the Food and Drug Administration, and other U.S. Government entities.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Division of Digital Health Policy were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services on June 27, 2023, and effective on August 8, 2023.
