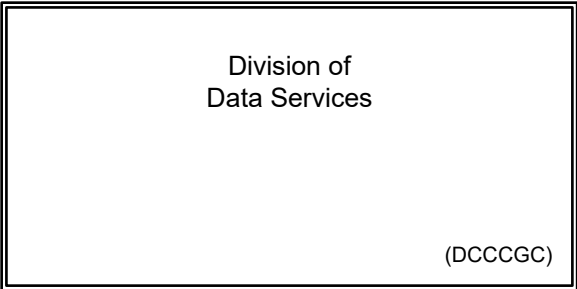
1. Division of Data Services (DCCCGC).

- A. Leads data governance for the Center for Devices and Radiological Health fostering data quality and stewardship across the business enterprise.
- B. Directs and implements data initiatives including data governance, data harmonization, and data analytics that enable data scientists to address pressing public health challenges related to medical devices.
- C. Defines, advocates for, and implements data exchange standards that are consistent with health information technology and the industry.
- D. Maintains secure, consistent and high-quality data to enable data-driven decision making with embedded analytics to inform business strategy, fostering data-fueled business growth and development, and advancing strategic initiatives.

2. Authority and Effective Date.
