

Cyclospora cayetanensis/(b)(5) (suspect)/Jun 2025 - CARA ID 1313

Between 6/23/2025 and 9/9/2025, CORE Signals was notified of (b)(5) restaurant clusters of cyclosporiasis illnesses associated with (b)(4) Points of Service (POS) in (b)(5) . State partners identified (b)(5) as a leading item of interest in all (b)(5) clusters, and on 7/11/2025 the incident was transferred from CORE Signals to CORE Response Team 2 for further coordination. Based on available epidemiologic data, FDA and state partners initiated a traceback investigation for (b)(5) consumed by 42 cases included in (b)(5) legs of traceback that reported consuming meals containing (b)(5) at these (b)(5) points of service. FDAs Office of Inspections and Investigations (OII)/Office of Human Food Inspectorate (OHFI) initiated records and information collection assignments at (b)(5) firms between 7/15/2025 and 9/17/2025. (b)(5) inspections were also conducted as part of this investigation. (b)(5) were joint inspections conducted by FDA, (b)(4) at (b)(4) FDA collected a total of (b)(5) import samples and (b)(5) (b)(4) samples during these inspections; all samples were negative for *Cyclospora*. Due to the lack of sufficient epidemiologic, traceback and laboratory data, (b)(5) remained the suspect vehicle for this outbreak investigation; a specific product and/or source of contamination was not identified. As of 11/19/2025, this incident includes total of 47 people with laboratory confirmed *Cyclospora* spp. infections in four states: (b)(5) . No hospitalizations or deaths were reported.
