The FDA has a requirement for a DNA Sonicator.

The Kochan Laboratory at The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires a DNA Sonicator, capable of shearing DNA to a range of different fragment sizes, for analysis in whole genome sequencing. Ongoing studies and experiments in the laboratory require large scale genomic sequencing, for which a Sonicator is needed for an early step of this process. The Sonicator needs to be able to process more than one (1) sample at a time, for high-throughput processing.
