

## **INFORMATION FOR RECIPIENTS AND CAREGIVERS**

**MFLUSIVA** (em floo see' vah)

(Influenza Vaccine, mRNA)

2026-2027 Formula

Please read this information sheet before getting MFLUSIVA. This summary is not intended to take the place of talking with your healthcare provider. If you have questions or would like more information, please talk with your healthcare provider.

### **What is MFLUSIVA?**

MFLUSIVA is a vaccine that helps protect against influenza disease (flu).

MFLUSIVA is for people 50 years of age and older. Vaccination with MFLUSIVA may not protect all people who receive the vaccine.

MFLUSIVA does not contain the influenza viruses. MFLUSIVA cannot give you influenza disease.

### **Who should not get MFLUSIVA?**

You should not get MFLUSIVA if you had:

- a severe allergic reaction to any ingredient in MFLUSIVA (see **What are the ingredients in MFLUSIVA?**).

### **What should I tell my healthcare provider?**

Tell your healthcare provider about all of your medical conditions, including if you:

- have any allergies
- had a severe allergic reaction after receiving a previous dose of any other vaccine
- have had Guillain-Barré syndrome (severe muscle weakness) after getting an influenza vaccine
- are immunocompromised or are on a medicine that affects your immune response
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant
- are breastfeeding
- have ever fainted in association with an injection

### **How is MFLUSIVA given?**

MFLUSIVA is given as an injection into the muscle.

### **What are the risks of MFLUSIVA?**

There is a very small chance that MFLUSIVA could cause a severe allergic reaction. A severe allergic reaction would usually occur within a few minutes to one hour after getting a dose of MFLUSIVA. For this reason, your healthcare provider may ask you to stay for a short time at the place where you received your vaccine. Signs of a severe allergic reaction may include:

- trouble breathing
- swelling of your face and throat
- a fast heartbeat
- a rash all over your body
- dizziness and weakness

Side effects that have been reported in clinical trials with MFLUSIVA include:

Local reactions that may occur at or around the injection site

- pain
- tenderness and swelling of the lymph nodes in the same arm of the injection
- swelling (hardness)
- redness

General side effects

- fatigue
- headache
- Muscle pain or joint pain
- chills or fever
- nausea or vomiting

These may not be all of the possible side effects of MFLUSIVA. Ask your healthcare provider about any side effects that concern you. You may report side effects to the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) at 1-800-822-7967 or <https://vaers.hhs.gov>.

**What are the ingredients in MFLUSIVA?**

MFLUSIVA contains the following ingredients:

- messenger ribonucleic acid (mRNA)
- lipids (SM-102, polyethylene glycol [PEG] 2000 dimyristoyl glycerol [DMG], cholesterol, and 1,2-distearoyl-sn-glycero-3-phosphocholine [DSPC])
- tromethamine
- tromethamine hydrochloride
- sucrose

MFLUSIVA does not contain egg protein, antibiotics, or preservatives. Cells are not used in MFLUSIVA's manufacturing process.
