The FDA has a requirement for a One-Year Maintenance Agreement for an Incucyte S3 Live-Cell Imager.

The FDA Center for Biologics Evaluation and Research (CBER), Office of Vaccines Research and Review, Silver Spring, Maryland, operates an Incucyte S3 live-cell imaging instrument (Serial # 1C50633) used to support mission-critical research in the Laboratory of Immunobiochemistry to ensure continued operational readiness and instrument integrity. CBER requires a 12-month preventive service plan that can be maintained by a company that is authorized by the original equipment manufacturer (OEM), Sartorius Corporation, to do so.

The laboratory is responsible for evaluating the potency of standardized allergenic extracts licensed for distribution in the United States and developing test methods for standardizing and evaluation of potency of non-standardized allergenic extracts. The Incucyte S3 live-cell imager measures fluorescence when labeled antibodies are added to the cells in culture.
