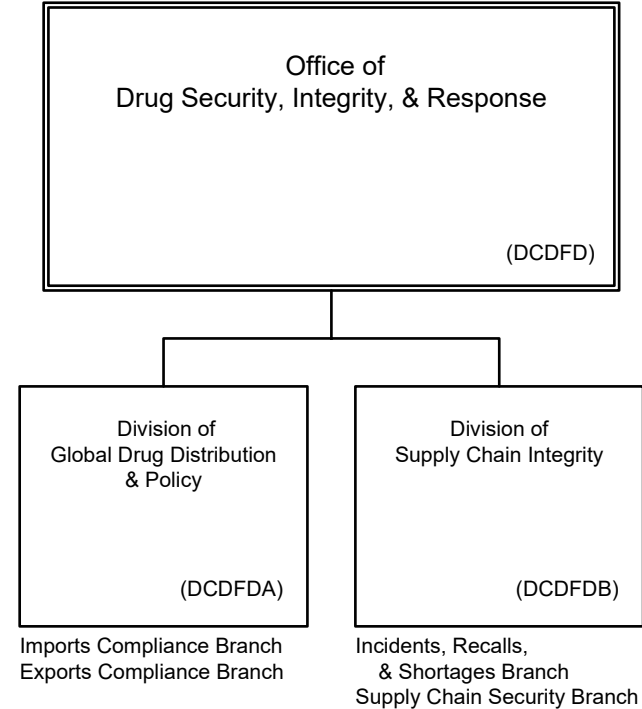
**1. Office of Drug Security, Integrity, and Response (DCDFD).**

- A. Develops policies and compliance strategies for protecting the public health by assuring drug product quality and supply chain integrity.
- B. Coordinates evaluation and classification of drug recalls and provides Center coordination with field Offices for implementation of recalls and monitors resolution of related compliance issues.
- C. Ensures integrity of imported drugs by assuring compliance with applicable legal requirements.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**

The functional statements for the Office of Drug Security, Integrity, and Response were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
