
1. Office of Minority Health and Health Equity (DCM).

- A. Serves as principal advisor to the Commissioner and other key Food and Drug Administration (FDA) officials on scientific and policy issues relating to the health of all Americans.
- B. Provides leadership and policy direction for FDA regarding issues relating to the health of all Americans.
- C. Coordinates FDA scientific, policy, communication, and outreach activities to promote the health of all populations through research and communications that support the regulatory decision-making process.
- D. Promotes participation of all Americans on FDA advisory committees and in training, internship, and fellowship programs.
- E. Advocates, collaborates, and partners within and outside FDA for participation in clinical trials.
- F. Facilitates FDA communication and serves as the FDA liaison with internal and external stakeholders regarding the health of all Americans.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Minority Health and Health Equity were approved by the Chief Financial Officer and effective on March 15th, 2025.
