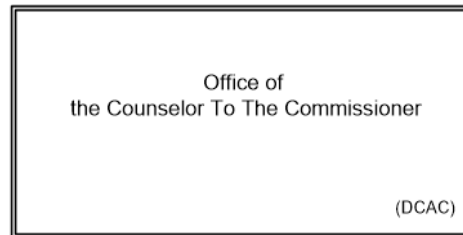
1. Office of the Counselor to the Commissioner (DCAC).

- A. Formulates and renders advice to the Commissioner related to policy development, interpretation and integration that cuts across program lines or which is not well defined.
- B. Provides a leadership role in advocating for and advancing the Commissioner's priorities
- C. Reviews recommendations for actions and reviews other materials to ensure that all points of view and program interests are developed for consideration and fully analyzed.
