**1. Division of Regulatory Policy III (DCDBD).**

- A. Initiates, develops, and reviews regulations, policies, procedures and guidance's that affect the regulation of drugs under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
- B. Serves as the Center's focal point on regulatory issues providing advice and assistance on such matters as scope, applicability and meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act other laws, regulations, and policies.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**

The functional statements for the Division of Regulatory Policy III were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
