DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:

OBSERVATION 1

Your written SE prevention plan lacks appropriate SE prevention measures.

Specifically, during review of your written "SE MONITORING AND CONTROL PROGRAM", on 6/14/2011 it was noted that your plan lacks: Cleaning and disinfection procedures.

OBSERVATION 2

Stray animals are not prevented from entering poultry houses.

Specifically, on 6/15/2011, a large black and red wild bird was observed in house #36.

OBSERVATION 3

You do not maintain practices that will protect against cross contamination when equipment is moved among poultry houses.

Specifically, during review of your written "SE MONITORING AND CONTROL PROGRAM", on 6/14/2011 it was noted that your plan states, "Equipment need not be disinfected between buildings as long as all flocks remain negative".

On 6/15/2011:

- A ladder was used in house #25 and then moved into house #26 without being cleaned or disinfected between houses.
- A bicycle was used by an employee to move between house #20 and #24, while passing through houses #21-23, without being cleaned or disinfected between houses.
- A bicycle was used by an employee to move between house #34 and #39, while passing through houses #35-38, without being cleaned or disinfected between houses.

OBSERVATION 4

You do not maintain practices that will protect against cross contamination when people move between poultry houses.

Specifically, during review of your written "SE MONITORING AND CONTROL PROGRAM", on 6/14/2011 it was noted that your plan only address cross contamination when people move between poultry houses if your firm has had a SE environmental positive.

OBSERVATION 5

Potential harborages for pests in and outside your poultry house have not been eliminated by removing debris and vegetation outside the poultry house.

Specifically, on 6/15/11, a vegetable garden was noticed have been planted and currently growing east of house number #23. Also, two trees, one tree containing a wild birds nest, were growing onto multiple houses between houses #34 and #30 located on the south side of your egg farm.

OBSERVATION 6

The presence of flies is not monitored by appropriate monitoring methods.

Specifically, during review of your written "SE MONITORING AND CONTROL PROGRAM", on 6/14/2011 it was noted that your plan states, "Fly monitoring and fly control are conducted on a whole ranch basis".

OBSERVATION 7

The presence of rodents is not monitored by appropriate monitoring methods.

Specifically, during review of your written "SE MONITORING AND CONTROL PROGRAM", on 6/14/2011 it was noted that your plan states, "Rodent monitoring and rodent control are conducted on a whole ranch basis".
