1. DIVISION OF SOCIAL SCIENCES (DJJHJA).

- A. Provides the Center and Office of Foods management with analyses of the impacts of policy options on affected parties, including industries, FDA, other governments, and consumers.
- B. Performs economic and Paperwork Reduction Act analyses on proposed and final regulations and guidance documents. .
- C. Conducts primary economic research of regulated industries
- D. Advises Center and Office of Foods management of the impact of nutrition and labeling policy options on consumers.
- E. Conducts primary research on consumer awareness, attitudes, knowledge, and practices to inform Center and Office of Foods policy decisions.
- F. Supports Center and Agency risk communication with research-based messages and program design.

The functional statements for this Division were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services, effective October 1, 2012.
