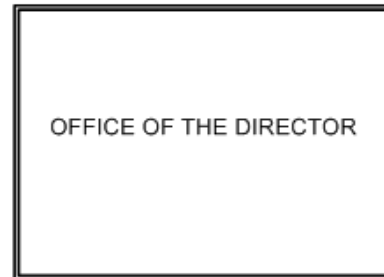
1. DIVISION OF BUSINESS ANALYSIS AND REPORTING (DKKNTBB).

- A. Supports the user community through centralized reporting. Determines Center reporting requirements as regulations, policies, and program needs change.
- B. Develops management reports needed on a continual basis from the corporate database.
- C. Provides additional data analysis and information to address specific questions and issues, as they arise.
- D. Coordinates data and information requests (e.g., for Press Inquiries, Freedom of Information (FOIs), Congressional reports, General Accounting Office (GAO) and Office of Inspector General (OIG) studies.
