### Lifetime Achievement Award

#### 2013-Present

The category recognizes an individual who has been with FDA for at least 15 years and has made significant contributions to regulatory science at the Agency, either through a single scientific contribution or a body of work. These contributions must have had a lasting impact on the science supporting FDA's mission and must have demonstrated a lifetime commitment to public health. Current and retired FDA staff may be nominated and posthumous nominations are also accepted.

#### 2013

**Bob Rappaport, M.D., CDER**

*For lasting contributions to the anesthesia, analgesia, and addiction fields by accelerating the discovery and development of new drugs with improved efficacy and safety.*
