
**1. Division of Product Science (DCFDC).**

- A. Provides scientific expertise related to regulated tobacco products design, ingredients, additives, and constituents.
- B. Develops and implements policies and procedures governing the tobacco product aspects of premarket review of reports of substantially equivalent (SE) tobacco products, exemptions from SE, applications for new tobacco products, and modified risk tobacco products.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**
