1. Division of Regulatory Science Informatics (DCFDB).

- A. Identifies advocates, and coordinates the identification, development, and management of tools and systems to support the regulatory science evaluation and approval of tobacco products.
- B. Leads information management activities and promotes efficient and informative data analysis methods to support the review and regulation of tobacco products for the Office of Science (OS).
- C. Provides IT leadership, advocacy, direction, coordination and tracking for specific IT projects associated with the improvement of Center for Tobacco Products (CTP) regulatory informatics on behalf of OS.
- D. Provides leadership, direction, policy development and coordination on strategic scientific computing plans and their implementation.
- E. Develops support and communication activities to ensure timely service and information sharing to both internal and external OS stakeholders.
- F. Develops electronic submission and data standards and associated regulatory guidance and process and tools to maximize efficiency and consistency of regulatory and scientific reviews.
- G. Develops requirements for information management systems and maintain them to support the full range of regulatory science projects, including preparation of reports for management use.
