
1. Division of Filing Review (DCDMDB).

- A. Reviews newly submitted Abbreviated New Drug Applications submitted under section 505(j) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act on equivalence standards for generics drugs including complex products to determine if they are sufficiently complete to be received.
- B. Monitors and issues Refusal to Receive letters.
- C. Provides evaluation of patent and exclusivity issues.
- D. Determines the appropriate prioritization of applications received for medically necessary drug products.
- E. Assesses requests for changes to approved drug products.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Division of Filing Review were approved by the Commissioner of Food and Drugs on September 8, 2020, and effective on October 9, 2020.
