REGULATORY - FOOD AND COSMETICS

Determinations Related to Processes or Treatments Not Meeting the Requirements of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act

Effective Date: September 3, 2014

1. AUTHORITY DELEGATED AND TO WHOM DELEGATED.

- A. The following officials are authorized to perform all the functions of the Commissioner of Food and Drugs (“Commissioner”) under section 403 (h)(3)(B)(ii) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FD&C Act) to make determinations that a process or treatment has not been shown to meet the requirements of section 403(h)(3)(B)(i)(I) through (III) of the FD&C Act.
1. The Director and Deputy Directors, Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition (CFSAN), Office of Foods and Veterinary Medicine (OFVM)
 2. The Director and Deputy Director, Office of Food Safety, CFSAN, OFVM
 3. The Division Director, Division of Plant and Dairy Food Safety, Office of Food Safety, CFSAN, OFVM.

2. REDELEGATION.

These officials may not further re-delegate this authority.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Commissioner approved this delegation, via memorandum, on September 3, 2014.
