1. OFFICE OF PUBLIC HEALTH STRATEGY AND ANALYSIS (DNND).

- A. Acts as Office of the Commissioner and Agency resource for quantitative research and analysis on emerging issues, including helping to develop policy options and understanding the expected impact of those options on public health outcomes.
- B. Advances and informs work on priority public health and scientific initiatives and issues at the request of the Agency Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner for Policy, Planning, Legislation, and Analysis.
- C. Acts as Agency lead for interactions with Reagan-Udall Foundation (RUF), leads and coordinates Agency strategy for RUF's public-private collaborations to promote safety and better evidence, improve regulatory science processes and build scientific capacity.
- D. Leads Agency efforts on transparency, including potential public access to Agency information and greater transparency regarding Agency procedures.
- E. Develops and executes research to improve the agency's ability to link agency activities and outputs to public health outcomes.
- F. Provides leadership on linking Agency work to Healthy People objectives, including the development of new objectives for areas that are within Agency's responsibility.
- G. Prepares and presents research papers, briefings, lectures, training, and other communications as necessary to disseminate the results of the program's work both within Agency and publicly.
- H. Works with the appropriate agency experts to provide strategic thinking and leadership with respect to management of Government Accountability

Office (GAO) and Office of the Inspector General (OIG) studies, and ensures that GAO and OIG engage with the appropriate agency experts and receive accurate and timely information in response to their requests.

- I. Provides study teams with strategic advice on how to articulate Agency's message in response to GAO and OIG reports most effectively.
- J. Updates the status of the agency's implementation of GAO/OIG recommendations.

2. AUTHORITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

The functional statements for this Office were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services, and effective on September 26, 2014.
