OGD Virtual Hiring Event Q&A

Q: How can I come to know that my Resume/CV has been selected for the further Process of hiring "If the Group is Interested"?

A: All resumes are in the process of being triaged and reviewed by our staff. If they are interested, they will contact you directly.

Q: I wanted to check regarding the pharmacologist position in OGD

A: Please go to www.fda.gov/gdufahiring for the most up to date Pharmacologist announcement.

Q: Are there any openings for green card holders (Permanent residents)?

A: Positions available for Green Card holders are under our Title 42 program. Under this program we seek those with experience in Pharmacology, Toxicology, and Chemistry.

Q: I am a pharmacist interested to work with your office, how will this OGD program help my employment?

A: As a Pharmacist in OGD, you will gain a wealth of knowledge and serve a greater purpose, of assisting in our mission to make generic drugs available to the American public. The therapeutic knowledge of drug products obtained in pharmacy school and experience as a Pharmacist in the retail setting will lay the foundation for your job in OGD. As a Pharmacist, you will use this experience to oversee the Abbreviated New Drug Applications (ANDAs) process. You will also serve as the primary point of contact between the FDA and the applicants.

Q: Currently it shows closed so wanted to check whether pharmacologist positions are currently open??

A: Although the announcement is currently closed, we are always reviewing resumes for the position. We recommend to check the www.fda.gov/gdufahiring site often for updates and openings for the position.

Q: Is there a time frame to receive a notice if one is being considered for a position?

A: There is no specific time frame to receive a notice on consideration for the position. The resumes are triaged and reviewed by our staff, if they are interested, they will contact you directly.

Q: Do i still apply at usajobs after submitting my resume? If so under which announcement or control number

A: You may still apply to the announcement, go to www.fda.gov/gdufahiring and select the position to view our current announcement for your discipline.

Q: Would you recommend that the resume contain information on immigration status such as a permanent resident

A: Yes, we recommend you indicate your immigration status on your resume for appropriate position selection.

Q: Brandy Sims: I sent my resume when I registered for this event and applied for the nurse consultant position on USA jobs, will FDA begin the hiring process after this event

A. The resumes are being triaged and reviewed by our hiring managers, if they are interested they will contact you directly.

Q: When is the hiring period over?

A: Hiring will continue on a rolling basis, until we have met our needs.

Q: Can you please provide the email for CV submitting again?

A. Resumes can be sent to OGD_GDUFA_Hiring@fda.hhs.gov

Q: When will these GDUFA's positions available on USAJOBS site?

A: These positions are announced through USAJobs. We recommend going to www.fda.gov/gdufahiring to direct you to the correct announcement.

Q: Is it possible to apply for a position in FDA without green card?

A: If you are a U.S. Citizen you may apply for a position without a green card. If you are not a U.S. Citizen, a Green Card, or Visa will be required.

Q: what is the timelines for decision regarding the pharmacologist position?

A: There is no official timeline. The position will be filled on a rolling basis until our hiring needs are met.

Q: USAJobs is only for US citizens but I am a permanent resident so how do we apply

A: To apply, you will send your resume to OGD_GDUFA_Hiring@fda.hhs.gov for consideration. If the hiring manager is interested, they will contact you directly and walk you through the next steps of the process.

Q: how do we follow up on application status

A: Once you apply to USAjobs, USAjobs will provide you email updates on the status of the application.

Q: are you hiring biologist

A: At this time, OGD is not hiring Biologists. We recommend checking www.fda.gov/gdufahiring for this position's availability in other organizations.

Q: where will i find staff felllow positions?

A; To apply for a Staff Fellow position, you will send your resume to OGD_GDUFA_Hiring@fda.hhs.gov for consideration. If the hiring manager is interested, they will contact you directly and walk you through the next steps of the process.

Q: My PhD degree name is not Pharmacology, but my thesis work involved pharmacology work, am I qualified to apply for pharmacology related positions?

A: The following are the requirements for the Pharmacologist (0405) series. More information on this can be found at www.opm.gov

Degree: major in an appropriate biological, medical, veterinary, or physical science, or in pharmacy that included at least 30 semester hours in chemistry and physiology and 12 semester hours in pharmacology.

Evaluation of Education: The positions in this series are multidisciplinary positions, since the work involves the application of a scientific knowledge of biochemistry, physiology, pharmacology, and such related sciences as microbiology, biophysics, genetics, mathematics, and statistics.

Courses in chemistry, organic chemistry, biochemistry, general physiology, and animal, human, microbial, or cellular physiology may be used to meet the 30-semester-hour requirement in chemistry and physiology. Under some circumstances, i.e., where the course work provided additional insight into the biophysical, biochemical, and physiological relationships involved, courses in such subjects as cytology, embryology, cellular or microbial genetics, and biophysics may be used to meet this requirement.

Courses in pharmacology, pharmacodynamics, pharmacotherapeutic, molecular pharmacology, and other similar subjects may be used to meet the 12-semester-hour requirement in pharmacology. Courses dealing intensively with pharmacologically-oriented subjects may also be used to meet this requirement.

Q: How soon after this virtual hiring event can we expect to hear whether or not we have been selected?

A: The resumes are being triaged and reviewed by our hiring managers, if they are interested they will contact you directly.

Q: Is a higher grade 12 positions available for pharmacist positions can i still apply

A: You will want to review the qualifications for each grade level under the position. Please see the below information for the announcement:

For **GS-12**:

Applicants must possess one (1) year of professional pharmacy specialized experience equivalent to the GS-11 grade level or equivalent band level in the Federal service which has equipped you with the specific knowledge, skill and ability to perform successfully in this position, coordinating and managing the activities of medical project areas and evaluating the progress to ensure timely completion; evaluating and interpreting contents of submitted professional and consumer labeling information; preparing written analyses and evaluation for professionals and participates in discussions; gathering information, identifying problems and developing scientific, risk-based approaches to assignments which are appropriate and consistent with office policy.

For GS-13:

Applicants must possess one (1) year of professional pharmacy specialized experience equivalent to the GS-12 grade level or equivalent band level in the Federal service which has equipped you with the specific knowledge, skill and ability to perform successfully in this position, coordinating and managing the activities of medical project areas and evaluating the progress to ensure timely completion; evaluating and interpreting contents of submitted professional and consumer labeling information; prepare written analyses and evaluation for professionals and participates in discussions; gathering information, identifying problems and developing scientific, risk-based approaches to assignments which are appropriate and consistent with office policy; AND/OR providing advice, consultation, and assistance on post-marketing surveillance of drug products and their applications; preparing summaries describing clinical assessment of adverse reaction analyses; and contributing to the development and improvement of procedures for post-marketing surveillance and the processing and evaluation of adverse drug product reaction reports.

Q: What advice do you have for someone who is not in a government position and has never been for applying for position at FDA?

A: We recommend doing as much research about the position and office as possible. A good place to start would be to go to www.opm.gov first to view the Position Qualifications for the Position/Series you are interested in applying for. This will provide you information on the qualifications, and assist you identify items you will want to highlight on your resume. You can also use the resume creator tool on USAjobs.gov. Furthermore, view www.fda.gov/gdufahiring to get information on our current positions available.

Q: I have applied that I am from India. Is that ok or have to mention in separately

A: You should indicate on your resume your location and citizenship status for appropriate position selection.

Q: Hi I have sent my CV for chemist role, who and what info discuss now here?

A: During our hiring fair, you will want to listen to information from our Office of Research Standards. This office focuses on therapeutic performance research and the other on quantitative methods and modeling.

Q: Are multiple departments looking for pharmacists?

A: Yes, multiple divisions within OGD are hiring Pharmacists.

Q: Are you recruiting Inspectors?

A: OGD does not recruit Inspectors. We recommend visiting positions under ORA.

Q: Hello, I am applying for pharmacist position. I submitted this position thru usajob. Do I have to resubmit the application?

A: If you have already applied to USAjobs, you do not need to submit a new application. Please be sure to send your resume to OGD GDUFA Hiring@fda.hhs.gov.

Q: Hello, Does it help if we have references in FDA/advisors who have workedthere?

A: If you are selected, and we begin seeking references: All references will need to be from the outside of FDA.

Q: I submitted my CV can I resubmit in the correct resume format posted on USAJOB

A: Yes, you may submit the format used on USAjobs.

Q: There is no email adress avialble in the confirmation email. Can you provide again

A: Resumes can be sent to <a>OGD_GDUFA_Hiring@fda.hhs.gov

Q: Good afternoon, I have submitted my resume to the email address provided. I understand that the next steps would be to submit my application to USAjobs. What typically is the turnarond time to hear back?
