- collaborates with other components of NLM involved in similar activities, including the National Network of Libraries of Medicine



NLM Supported Breastfeeding Outreach







Project components

- Key informant interviews with Tribal health personnel.
- Consumer survey of prenatal women in selected Tribes to determine sources of information regarding breastfeeding.
- Develop a prenatal curriculum targeting grandparents at Penobscot Indian Nation.
- Provide breastfeeding peer counselor training.
- Develop culturally appropriate educational resources to support breastfeeding with information about the National Library of Medicine portals.







Outcomes



- · Intergenerational community action
- · Trained 4 new peer counselors
- · Increased communication between Tribe and community hospital
- Development of Penobscot Nation Health Department breastfeeding policy
- Development of Native breastmilk bank
- · Continued purchasing of breast pumps
- 3 home visits in the first week after new mothers come home to support breastfeeding
