

## **Comment on G/SPS/N/USA/854 from China**

Thank you for the opportunity that US FDA provides to make comment on the US SPS notification G/SPS/N/USA/854. Having examined the content of the notification, the AQSIQ would provide the following comments:

1. According to the WTO SPS Agreement, please provide the detailed list and limit standards, as well as the scientific evidence supporting the establishment of those limits;
2. Because some primary products are to be used for further processing, and the radiative materials might attenuate during the further processing, the products that covered by the CPG draft should be limited in products for direct consumption, that is, industrial further processed food products, instead of all food products.
3. Please provide the detailed laboratory testing data concerning the risks of radioelements (including all radiation origins) in food to human health.

Hope FDA will take China's comments into consideration and we are looking forward to the information mentioned above. Thank you.
