Before me, Jamie Wai, an employee of the Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug Administration, designated by the Secretary, under authority of the Act of January 31, 1925, 43 Statutes at Large 803; Reorganization Plan No. IV, Secs. 12-15, effective June 30, 1940; Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1953, Secs. 1-9, effective April 11, 1953; and P.L. 96-88, Sec. 509, 93 Statutes at Large 965 (20 U.S.C. 3508) effective May 4, 1980; to administer or take oaths, affirmations, and affidavits, personally appeared [REDACTED] CONSUMER in the county and State aforesaid, who, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I purchased two bottles of MetaboLife Dietary Supplement 356, 90 caplets, from [REDACTED] through the internet on February 10, 1999. A week after I received the dietary supplement, 3rd week into February, I started taking the supplement. I began taking two supplements before breakfast and two before dinner. I consumed them with water. On several days, I reduced the amount of the supplement to one supplement prior to breakfast and one prior to dinner. I did not take any supplements before lunch.

On March 5th, I consumed two supplements prior to breakfast with water. After breakfast, about 1-2 hours later I began experiencing an attack (numbness, increase heart rate, and no oxygen to the brain) at my son's school. I drove home and my mother then drove me to the hospital. I took the dietary supplement to lose weight. I do have an experience with tachycardia, a third episode.
