It was my pleasure to see Mr. [Redacted] in our office today for an echo-Doppler study. As you recall, he is a very pleasant 20-year-old white male who had a pronounced episode of dizziness a couple of weeks ago and has felt somewhat "funny" since that time.

I have enclosed a copy of the echo report. As you can see, it was an entirely normal study. Left ventricular systolic function was normal. All of the valves appeared fine. There was no evidence of congenital heart disease.

I hope this provides you with useful information. I suspect that Mr. [Redacted] symptoms may have been due to dehydration, as he had played golf and worked out that day prior to the onset of the symptoms. If his symptoms should recur, then we can pursue further testing.

Thank you for allowing us to participate in his care.
