

Dear Ms. Walsh: Pursuant to notice published in the Fed. Reg., I am presenting my written views to the vaccines advisory committee. I urge the advisory committee to base its recommendation on safety and efficacy. I urge the committee to resist pressure to consider morality, values, or politics in making its recommendation. I see a political movement that undertakes to deny women the benefits of medical advances that enhance women's health and allow women control of their lives and bodies. If this vaccine is medically safe and effective, as I understand the evidence to show, the committee should recommend its approval. If the issue is whether and when to vaccinate a girl or young woman, that decision must be left to parents and/or the girl in consultation with the medical professional involved.
