Dear Ms. Henney,



2. The adoption of strict regulations in regards to the testing of all genetically modified foods for health and safety.
3. A comprehensive assessment plan to address the question of environmental risks associated with GMO's.

I urge you to support the legal petition filed by the Center For Food Safety to the FDA. in addition to the mandatory labeling and food safety bills that were recently introduced in congress: HR3377 and S2080 (The Genetically Engineered Food Right To Know Acts ). Also, HR3883, The Genetically Engineered Food Safety Act.

Your support of these common sense measures will be watched by a large segment of the population, not only by those who write and telephone in their support.


