Dear Ms. Henney:


I am writing you to express concern about genetically engineered food. While there seems to be positive sides to the issue, I think that there is not sufficient information to determine the long term effects on human health and the environment. I think there should be mandatory testing on all GE foods before being put on the market shelves.

I grow some of my food and buy organic food and have found that my health has improved over the years, for the nutrients in these foods are more readily absorbed into the body. I've read reports that GE agriculture has the potential to put organic foods at risk due to "genetic drift." I have a concern that the food supply I depend upon for my health and well being is being jeopardized.

I also demand that these foods be labeled so that I as a consumer have a choice, particularly because studies have shown that GE foods could create allergic reactions and other dietary risks and should not be generally recognized as safe.
