
Dear Ms. Oliver:

I am writing to encourage the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to expedite the publication for public comment of the petition filed with FDA on February 17, 2000, by the National Yogurt Association (NYA) to revise the Federal standard of identity for yogurt.

Based on information I have received, NYA has proposed a revision which would enhance the current yogurt standard, while clarifying that yogurt is a food product containing a minimum level of specific live and active cultures. The proposed standard takes into account current industry practices and recognizes the need to allow for the use of future technologies. This proposed standard is clear, consistent, modern, and flexible, and will benefit both industry and consumers.
