



## 7.0 Combination Products

In the reserved section for permitted combinations of allowable active ingredients (333.420) the Agency does not address whether or not the combination of allowable actives (i.e. iodine and alcohol) is permitted under the monograph. Further as previously stated in section 6.0, *Active ingredients vs. Inactive Ingredient*, when products must rely upon known active antimicrobials listed as inactive preservatives to pass the proposed test methods it would be appropriate to have them considered as Combination products as well (Table; Topical Antimicrobial Ingredients, Summary of Health-Care Antiseptic Active Ingredients, Pages FR 31435 & 31436). The final monograph must clarify whether combination products (i.e. two or more antimicrobials) is allowed under 333.420.
