We would like to express our concerns on The Food Allergen Labeling Protection Act that requires the FDA to define "GLUTEN FREE" for food labels. We are in favor of having all foods that are gluten free to be so labeled.

Labeled foods that are marked "gluten free" means that those of us with celiac disease can be assured that the food is safe for us to eat.

We now have to read the fine print of listing the "Ingredients" on packages to be sure that there are no wheat or wheat products which all contain gluten is contained therein.

There are hardly any foods that are marked "gluten free" except occasionally some prepared foods that are carried in health food stores.

"Gluten free" printed in bolder type letters would definitely influence our purchases of all food products so designated.
