## NEW Compounded Product Announcement

### *Budesonide + Formoterol Suspension for Aerosol Treatment*

For several years physicians around the country have been searching for a substitute for Advair Diskus (Fluticasone + Salmeterol) that could be administered through the nebulizer.

We now are pleased to notify you of our ability to compound Budesonide 250mcg or 500 mcg (Pulmocort) + Formoterol 12mcg (Foradil) for your nebulizer patients.

In our compounded Budesonide + Formoterol suspension, Formoterol (a long acting bronchodilator) is substituted for Salmeterol (the long acting bronchodilator found in Advair) and Budesonide (the corticosteroid in Pulmocort) is substituted for Fluticasone (the inhaled corticosteroid in Advair).

Many physicians feel this combination of drugs is a very good therapeutic substitute for Advair Diskus. Budesonide + Formoterol is supplied in a 3cc heat sealed unit dose vial. And is available as Budesonide 250mcg + Formoterol 12mcg or Budesonide 500mcg + Formoterol 12mcg. The product is prescribed twice-daily AM and PM. This product complies with all state pharmacy compounding regulations.

Budesonide + Formoterol may be a better choice for your COPD patients for the following reasons:

- Aerosolized medications are tolerated well by all patients.
- Better deposition of medication for severely breathing (FEV <50%) impaired patients.
- No choking or coughing with aerosolized medications.
- Twice daily AM & PM dosing.
- Medicare covers nebulizer medications.

Due to the fact that Medicare does not cover Advair Diskus, the average cost of Advair Diskus 250mcg/50mcg to a Medicare patient having no prescription coverage is approximately \$150 per month. The cost to the Medicare beneficiary for Budesonide + Formoterol Solution would be \$48 per month. This treatment saves the Medicare patient over \$100 per month.
