DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:

1. Environmental testing for SE, using approved methods, was not done in a poultry house when any group of laying hens constituting the flock was 40 to 45 weeks of age.

Specifically, House #4 was tested at 46 weeks and 6 days of age, house # 2 was tested at 47 weeks and 3 days of age, house # 1 was tested at 45 weeks and 3 days of age, and house # 3 was tested at 50 weeks and 3 days of age.

2. You do not maintain records documenting compliance with refrigeration requirements.

Specifically, you do not monitor or maintain records of the temperature requirements during transportation of shell eggs.
