**DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:**

**OBSERVATION 1**

Potential harborage for pests in and outside your poultry house have not been eliminated by removing debris and vegetation outside the poultry house.

**Specifically,**

**A. On the north side of house # 18, there were cow manure piles. The cow manure piles were approximately three feet away from the perimeter of house # 18. The cow piles were too numerous to count. According to your SE plan, all debris within 50 feet of all layer houses must be removed. Between house #15 and house #16, there was one cow manure pile.**

**B. On the north side of house #14, the cool cell pad was dripping, causing a pooling of water approximately ten feet by five feet, near the house.**

**C. On the south side of house # 15 the cool block which re-circulates waste-water from the cooling cells was leaking into a rut in the ground. The rut was created by a tractor tire and was approximately ten feet long and one foot wide.**
