**DURING AN INSPECTION OF YOUR FIRM WE OBSERVED:**

**OBSERVATION 1**

Your pullet environment is not tested for SE when pullets are 14 to 16 weeks of age.

Specifically, you sampled House 3 for SE on 8/26/2010. This sample date was not conducted within the required time frame of 14-16 weeks of age (9/2/2010 through 9/16/2010) as required for pullets.

**OBSERVATION 2**

Your written SE prevention plan is not fully implemented and followed.

Specifically,

- your firm did not monitor for flies in House 1 and 2 from 7/9/2010 through 9/5/2010. Furthermore, you did not monitor for flies in House 3 from 7/9/2010 through 9/20/2010.
- your firm did not monitor refrigeration temperatures for your egg cooler from 7/9/2010 to 9/30/2010.

**OBSERVATION 3**

Eggs were not held at or below 45 deg. F beginning 36 hours after time of lay.

Specifically, on 5/3/2011, we reviewed your refrigeration temperature logs from 10/1/2010 through 5/3/2011 for your egg cooler which showed multiple times (60 or more) that the average temperature went above 45 deg F.

**OBSERVATION 4**

Stray animals are not prevented from entering poultry houses.

Specifically, we observed 3 access points along the western wall of ~~House 2~~ House 1.

- 1.) an approximate 1" X 2" hole at the northern end (rear).

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- 2.) an approximate 2" X 8" hole at the southern end (front) where the block and concrete patches were degrading.
- 3.) an approximate 2" diameter hole near the ground at the southern end (front) where PVC pipe was inserted into the building.

**OBSERVATION 5**

Potential harborage for pests in and outside your poultry house have not been eliminated by removing debris and vegetation outside the poultry house.

Specifically, we observed 8" long patches of vegetation within 3 feet of the exterior walls of poultry houses 1, 2, and 3.

**OBSERVATION 6**

All required records do not have the signature or initials of the person performing the operation or creating the record.

Specifically, refrigeration records do not contain a signature or initials of the person performing the operation as required.

**OBSERVATION 7**

All your required records do not include the time of the activity that the records reflect.

Specifically, rodent, fly, and refrigeration records do not contain the time the activity took place.

**OBSERVATION 8**

Supervisory personnel responsible for ensuring compliance with the SE prevention plan(s).

did not review refrigeration, rodent, and fly monitoring records from 7/9/2010 through 5/3/2011.
